

## Art.01 – ORGANISER and CALENDAR

The Alpe Adria Rallye Club (AARC), Spitalgasse 15 – 9300 St. Veit/Glan (Organiser), announces and promotes the

**AARC – Club Championship**, hereafter called **AARC** and the

**AART – Club Championship**, hereafter called **AART**

These Club Championships offer all its registered club members special discounts at the listed events.

Everyone can choose from the following events, out of a maximum of 5 possible participations the best 4 results will be valid for the final classification (see Art.06).

The rules state that after two participations in the mentioned countries a third start will not be valid for the AARC/AART.

## Art.02 – ELIGIBLE COMPETITORS / TERMS OF PARTICIPATION

Eligible to compete in the AARC/AART are all registered drivers and co-drivers with a national or international rallying license who have paid the entry fee in due course. In order to be allowed to compete in AARC or AART, all competitors must completely fill out the entry form (download at [www.alpeadriarallyclub.eu](http://www.alpeadriarallyclub.eu)), sign it and then send it together with the payment receipt to Alpe Adria Rallye Club, Spitalgasse 15 - 9300 St. Veit/Glan.

**Membership fee AART** € 300.-  
**Membership fee Co-driver Trophy - applicable**

With the entry every driver/co-driver becomes a member of the “AARC/AART Club” for 2021 and is authorised to compete in the CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS organised by Alpe Adria Rallye Club.

**Entries are always open – no closing of entries!**

Benefits for the AARC and AART starter at the rallies:

- **Reduction on entry fees in the home country by: Voluntarily depending on the organizer from 15 - 25%**
- **Entry fee for events abroad\*: max. € 200.- (organizational fee)**

\*Referring to the country in which the driver is a licensee.

For participants from countries which don't host an AARC/AART-Rally, the Niederösterreich Rallye and Herbstrallye Dobersberg events will count as home events, referring to the entry fee.

Supplementary points will be awarded at these rallies according to Art. 05 (supplementary points).

The entry in AARC/AART is no guarantee for a fix slot on the entry list of the single events.

### Art.03 – ELIGIBLE CARS AARC / 2 WD

- C1** Group N, A and H over 2000cc
- C2** Group A and H from 1600cc up to 2000cc,  
FIA RC 3 (R3T, R3C)  
Super 1600,  
Diesel- and alternative fuel-powered cars
- C3** Group A and H up to 1600cc,  
FIA RC 4 (R2B, R2T)  
Kit Cars over 1600cc,  
Group N over 1600cc up to 2000cc
- C4** Group A and H up to 1400cc,  
FIA RC 5 (R1B, R1A)  
Kit Cars up to 1400cc,  
Group N up to 1600cc,-
- C5** Historic cars in compliance with the respective national ASN regulations separated into sub-classes  
**(Including 4WD)**
- C5.1** Historic Cars up to 1600 cc,  
**C5.2** Historic Cars up to 2000 cc,  
**C5.3** Historic Cars up to 2500 cc  
**C5.4** Historic Cars over 2500cc incl. All-wheel drive (4 WD)
- C6** 2 WD Cars with national homologation without engine capacity-subdivision, incl. M1.

### Art.04 – ELIGIBLE CARS - AARTP - 4 WD-Cars

- T1** FIA RC 2 (R5, R4, Super 2000, VR4)
- T2** Group N, A and H from 2000cc up to 2500cc
- T3** Group N, A and H over 2500cc, RGT, RGT-ASN national, Prototypes-ASN national (z. b. AMF „Open N“)

Awards will be handed over to the best three AARC/AART teams in the overall and group classifications.  
 Supplementary points will be awarded for these rallies according to Art.05 (supplementary points).  
 Prize money for AARC/AART is not envisaged for this season due to the lack of sponsors, but it still remains a possibility!

### Valid for all vehicles:

All cars must comply with the currently valid regulations of the ASN and the specific event regulations respectively.  
 The car's equipment must comply with the currently valid safety regulations of the FIA/ASN or with those of the respective event.  
**Info:** Additional, more restrictive technical regulations might come into effect due to additional regulations of the respective event.  
 Vehicles of Group H & Historic must comply with the national regulations of the ASN of the country in which the driver is a licensee.

### Art.05 - POINTS ATTRIBUTION

Points will be attributed at each event according to the table below:

For the overall classification all the achieved points for the overall and the group results (incl. supplementary points) will be added.  
 In case of less than 3 teams of the AARC or AART starting at a rally, the points for the overall classification will be reduced by 50%.

For the group classification all the achieved group points at the events will be added (incl. supplementary points).

## Supplementary points:

For the group and overall classification at each event the following supplementary points will be awarded:

- 2 Points for taking the start of the **1. Special Stage** at an event.
- 2 Points, if the participant finishes **the rally inside the score**.
- 10 Points, for the overall classification, if the participant **takes part in an event abroad**.
- 5 Points for the group classification, if the participant **takes part in an event abroad**.

**A maximum of 30 points for competing abroad will be awarded for the overall classification, a maximum of 15 points for the group classification! Only the first three participations abroad will be valid for the final classification!**  
Home country means the nation, in which the first driver has obtained his licence

**For participants from countries which don't host an AARC/AART-Rally, the Niederösterreich Rallye and Herbstrallye Dobersberg events will count as home events.**

## For the AARC/AART will be valid:

In case of 5 or more carried out events	the 4 best results
In case of 4 carried out events	all results

## Co-Driver Trophy:

Registered Co-Drivers receive the same amount of points as their AARC-registered driver.  
The best three Co-Drivers will receive trophies at the prize-giving at the end of the season.  
It is possible at any point to change the driver and / or switch from AARC to AART.

Only drivers who took part in at least 3 (three) events will be taken into consideration for the final overall classification.

## Other:

There will be a separate classification for drivers born after December 31, 1993 (Junior-Classification). There will be trophies from first to third place at the prize giving at the end of the season.

**From 6 registered junior teams, prize money will be paid according to the supplement.**

## Car change:

Participants are allowed to change the car which they entered at the start of the season as well as the group during the season. In this case the driver receives the points achieved in the group plus supplementary points and keeps the points for the **overall classification** but he will not be able to score points for the **group classification**. In case of a change from a vehicle eligible for the AARC to a vehicle eligible for the AART or vice versa points will only be awarded for the group classification.

## Art.07 – AWARDS & possible prize money

Awards (Trophies) and other prizes provided by sponsors will be handed over to the award winners at the end of the season during the AARC - prize giving ceremony. The venue and the participation modalities will be published by the organizer via a separate communication on the AARC website [www.alpeadriarallyclub.eu](http://www.alpeadriarallyclub.eu)

**If a sponsor should get involved the possible prize money will be paid out to the winning teams during the prize giving ceremony.**

## Attribution of awards:

The top three in the groups of AARCP/AARTP alike will be awarded with trophies.

In case of less than three teams in one group, these teams will be classified in the nearest group.

Overall and group winners will be the driver/co-driver combination who have achieved the highest number of points out of all valid events.

The overall winner of **AARC** receives the title „**AARC – CLUB-CHAMPION**“

The overall winner of **AART** receives the title „**AART – CLUB-CHAMPION**“

The overall winner of the **Junior-Classification** receives the title „**AARC - JUNIOR- CLUB-CHAMPION**“

The overall winner of the **Co-Drivers'-Trophy** receives the title „**AARC/AART CO-DRIVER'S CLUB-CHAMPION**“

## Art.07 - RESULTS / APPEALS / PARITY ON POINTS

For the 2021 season no event organiser is obliged to publish a separate AARC or AART classification. It also is not planned that the AARC/AART-winners will receive trophies at the event prize-giving. Should a rally organiser decide to do it, it is a voluntary act. The classification will be produced exclusively by the organising club on the basis of an approval-free Club Championship and will be published on the AARC homepage.

The point standings will be updated within one week after the event and will be published on the AARC-Homepage [www.alpeariarallyclub.eu](http://www.alpeariarallyclub.eu). Appeals against results must be presented by the driver in written form to the organizer within one week's time after the event. It's the organizer's responsibility to judge upon and to decide appeals. In case of parity on points in the overall or in a group classification the victory will be awarded to the driver who was better placed in the majority of events. If the parity remains the driver who has been classified in more events than the opponent will get the victory. In case of a further parity the result of the first rally of the season will be decisive.

## Art.08 - ADVERTISING

The participants are obliged to attach the official Club- and Sponsor-stickers to defined positions on the car. The organizer will provide the drivers with these stickers for free. The precise positions to attach the stickers will be published at least two weeks prior to the respective event on the AARC-Homepage [www.alpeadriarallyclub.eu](http://www.alpeadriarallyclub.eu) or send via E-Mail. At each event the organizer is allowed to request photographic material as a proof of the correct affixing of the stickers. If the stickers are not, or just partially, affixed, no points will be awarded to the driver at the event in question. If a driver is reluctant to affix the stickers he has to communicate his decision to the organizer at the latest one week prior to the event and has to attach to the letter a receipt of payment which amounts to 3 (three) times of the AARC entry fee.

## Art.09 – FINAL CLAUSE

Every change of date and/or a cancellation of an event valid for the AARC will be published at the AARC Website [www.alpeadriarallyclub.eu](http://www.alpeadriarallyclub.eu). Events are exclusively stated by the organizer and will be published on the Website. In case of issues or disputes concerning the interpretation, the regulations in German language will be consulted. These regulations may only be altered by an implementing provision (Bulletin) which will be published on the AARC-Website [www.alpeadriarallyclub.eu](http://www.alpeadriarallyclub.eu).
