IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING THE AARC/AART-CALENDAR 2026! (CHANGE)

As it is still uncertain whether the **Mühlstein-Rallye** will take place or no, **Rally Città di Scorzè** has been added to the calendar. If the **Mühlstein-Rallye** should be cancelled the **Rally Città di Scorzè** will be the substitute rally.

These two rallies will be offered as ***Joker-Rallies** and fifth rally of the season, which means the following:
If both races remain on the calendar, each team will only be allowed to score at one of these rallies.
This means that there are still 8 Rallies to choose from on the calendar.

Art.02 – ELIGIBLE COMPETITORS / TERMS OF PARTICIPATION

Eligible to compete in the AARC/AART Club Championship 2025 are all registered drivers and co-drivers with a national or international rallying license who have paid the membership fee in due course.

In order to be allowed to compete in AARC or AART, all competitors must completely fill out the entry form (download at www.alpeadriarallyclub.eu), sign it and then send it together with the payment receipt to Alpe Adria Rallye Club, Spitalgasse 15 - 9300 St. Veit/Glan.

ATTENTION: The co-pilot classification is not mandatory! Anniversary discount is only possible in combination! The co-pilot classification will be carried out separately for AARC and AART if at least 10 co-pilots have been named in each classification. Otherwise, the co-pilots of AARC & AART will be classified together.

The entry in AARC/AART is no guarantee for a fix slot on the entry list of the single events.

Art.03 - ELIGIBLE CARS AARC / 2WD

- C1** Group N, A and H over 2000cc
- C2** Group A and H from 1601cc to 2000 cc - A7,
FIA RC4, R3T, R3C, Super 1600, > Kit Car 1600
- C3** Group A and H up to 1600cc – A6
R2B, R2T, Kit Cars 1400 cc to 1600cc,
FIA RC5 incl. RC5 KIT
Group N from 1601cc to 2000cc - N3,
Diesel- and alternative-powered vehicles without capacity-subdivision.
- C4** Group A and H up to 1400ccm – A5,
Rally 6, R1, R1B & R1A, Kit Cars up to <1400ccm,
Group N up to 1600ccm, N2 & N1, Racing Start
- C5** Historic cars according to national ASN-regulations and Historic Technical Passport
(HTP-FIA/NAT), **including 4WD** divided in the following classes.
Turbo-factor Nominal capacity x 1,7
- C5.1** Historic Cars up to 1600 cc,
C5.2 Historic Cars from 1601 to 2000 cc,

Art.04 - ELIGIBLE CARS - AART / 4WD:

- T1** FIA RC2 (R5, Super 2000), N4, VR4, RRC, WRC 2,0 & 1,6
- T2** Group N, A and H from 2000cc to 2500cc, Nominal capacity incl. M1
- T3** Group N, A and H over 2500cc, FIA RC3, RGT, RGT-ASN national, Prototypes-ASN national (i e. AMF
„Open N“) + (ACI N5)

Valid for all vehicles: All cars must comply with the currently valid regulations of the ASN and the specific event regulations respectively. The car's equipment must comply with the currently valid safety regulations of the FIA/ASN or with those of the respective event.

Info: Additional, more restrictive technical regulations might come into effect due to additional regulations of the respective event. Vehicles of Group H & Historic must comply with the national regulations of the ASN of the country in which the driver is a licensee.

Art.05 - POINTS ATTRIBUTION

Points will be attributed at each event according to the table below:

For the overall classification all the achieved points for the overall and the group results (incl. supplementary points) will be added. In case of less than **3 teams** of the AARC or AART starting at a rally, the points for the overall classification will be **reduced by 25%**.

For the group classification all the achieved group points at the events will be added (incl. supplementary points). For the group and overall classification at each event the following supplementary points will be awarded:

Supplementary & Bonus points:

2 Extra Points for taking the start of the **1st Special Stage** at an event.

2 Extra Points, if the participant finishes **the rally inside the score**.

Bonus points for starts abroad will not be awarded in 2026, as a fair allocation is not possible.

NOTE:

Starting points, classification points and finish points are considered as a result and can be used as a drop result. A rally that has not started will also be counted as a bad result and can be considered a drop result.

For the AARC/AART will be valid:

In case of 7 - 9 events	the 6 best results
In case of 6 events	the 5 best results
If fewer than 5 events are held	all results

Only drivers who took part in at least 3 (three) events will be taken into consideration for the final overall classification.

Co-Driver Trophy:

Registered Co-Drivers receive the same amount of points as their AARC-registered driver.

The best three Co-Drivers, AARC & AART will receive trophies at the prize-giving at the end of the season.

It is possible at any point to change the driver.

Other:

There will be a separate classification for drivers of AARC born after December **31.12.2001**. There will be trophies from first to third place at the prizegiving at the end of the season.

Car change:

Participants are allowed to change the car which they entered at the start of the season as well as the group during the season.

When switching to a car in a higher group, the bonus- and group points are only considered for the overall standings. These points are not awarded in the group assigned at start of the season.

If a participant switches to a car that is classified in a lower group, they will be ranked in the group they were registered in at the beginning of the season.

It is not possible to change cars from AARC to AART or vice versa!

Art.06 – AWARDS & possible prize money

Awards (Trophies) and other prizes provided by sponsors will be handed over to the award winners at the end of the season during the AARC - prize giving ceremony. The venue and the participation modalities will be published by the organizer via a separate communication on the AARC website www.alpeadriarallyclub.eu

Prize money will be paid out to the winning person during the prize giving ceremony.

Unclaimed honorary prizes or prize money will be forfeited. Credits for the following year are only possible to a limited extent!

Attribution of awards:

The top three in the groups of AARC/AART alike will be awarded with trophies.

In case of less than three teams in one group, these teams will be classified in the nearest group.

Overall and group winners will be the driver/co-driver combination who have achieved the highest number of points out of all valid events.

The overall winner of **AARC** receives the title „**AARC CHAMPION**“

The overall winner of **AART** receives the title „**AART CHAMPION**“

The overall winner of the **Junior-Classification** receives the title „**AARC JUNIOR CHAMPION**“

The overall winner of the **Co-Drivers'-Trophy** receives the title „**AARC/AART CO-DRIVER'S CHAMPION**“

Art.07 - RESULTS / APPEALS / PARITY ON POINTS

For the 2025 season no event organiser is obliged to publish a separate AARC or AART classification. It also is not planned that the AARC/AART-winners will receive trophies at the event prize-giving. Should a rally organiser decide to do it, it is a voluntary act. The classification will be produced exclusively by the organising club on the basis of an approval-free Club Championship and will be published on the AARC homepage.

The point standings will be updated within one week after the event and will be published on the AARC-Homepage www.alpeariallyclub.eu. Appeals against results must be presented by the driver in written form to the organizer within one weeks' time after the event. It's the organizer's responsibility to judge upon and to decide appeals.

In case of parity on points in the overall or in a group classification the victory will be awarded to the driver who was better placed in the majority of events. If the parity remains the driver who has been classified in more events than the opponent will get the victory. In case of a further parity the result of the first rally of the season will be decisive.

Art.08 - ADVERTISING

The participants are obliged to attach the official Club- and Sponsor-stickers to defined positions on the car. The organizer will provide the drivers with these stickers for free. The precise positions to attach the stickers will be published at least two weeks prior to the respective event on the AARC-Homepage www.alpeadriallyclub.eu or send via E-Mail. At each event the organizer is allowed to request photographic material as a proof of the correct affixing of the stickers. If the stickers are not, or just partially, affixed, no points will be awarded to the driver at the event in question. If a driver is reluctant to affix the stickers he has to communicate his decision to the organizer at the latest one week prior to the event and has to attach to the letter a receipt of payment which amounts to 3 (three)times of the AARC entry fee.

Art.09 – FINAL CLAUSE

Every change of date and/or a cancellation of an event valid for the AARC will be published at the AARC Website www.alpeadriallyclub.eu

Events are exclusively stated by the organizer and will be published on the Website.

In case of issues or disputes concerning the interpretation, the regulations in German language will be consulted.

These regulations may only be altered by an implementing provision (Bulletin) which will be published on the AARC-Website www.alpeadriallyclub.eu.
